Amendment to the RFP for Youth Services Operator Posted: December 20, 2017

This amendment clarifies the difference between this Youth Services Operator RFP and the WIOA Youth Program Providers RFP, expected to be released in early 2018.

The purpose of this Youth Services Operator RFP is to select the organization that will be responsible for delivering services to youth under the WIOA Youth and Connecting Activities funding streams. The Youth Services Operator provides “Framework and General Services” under WIOA Youth and a variety of career development services under Connecting Activities. The selected Youth Services Operator may also manage other youth-focused programs under other funding streams that the REB may secure during the timeframe of the contract.

This Youth Services Operator RFP is different from the WIOA Youth Program Providers RFP. Different from the Youth Services Operator, WIOA Youth Program Providers receive funding from WIOA, via the REB, to implement career and academic programs that serve in-school and out-of-school youth. WIOA Youth Program Providers work in conjunction with the Youth Services Operator; the Program Providers implement the programs, while the Youth Services Operator provides Framework and General Services. The RFP for WIOA Youth Program Providers is expected to be released in early 2018.
